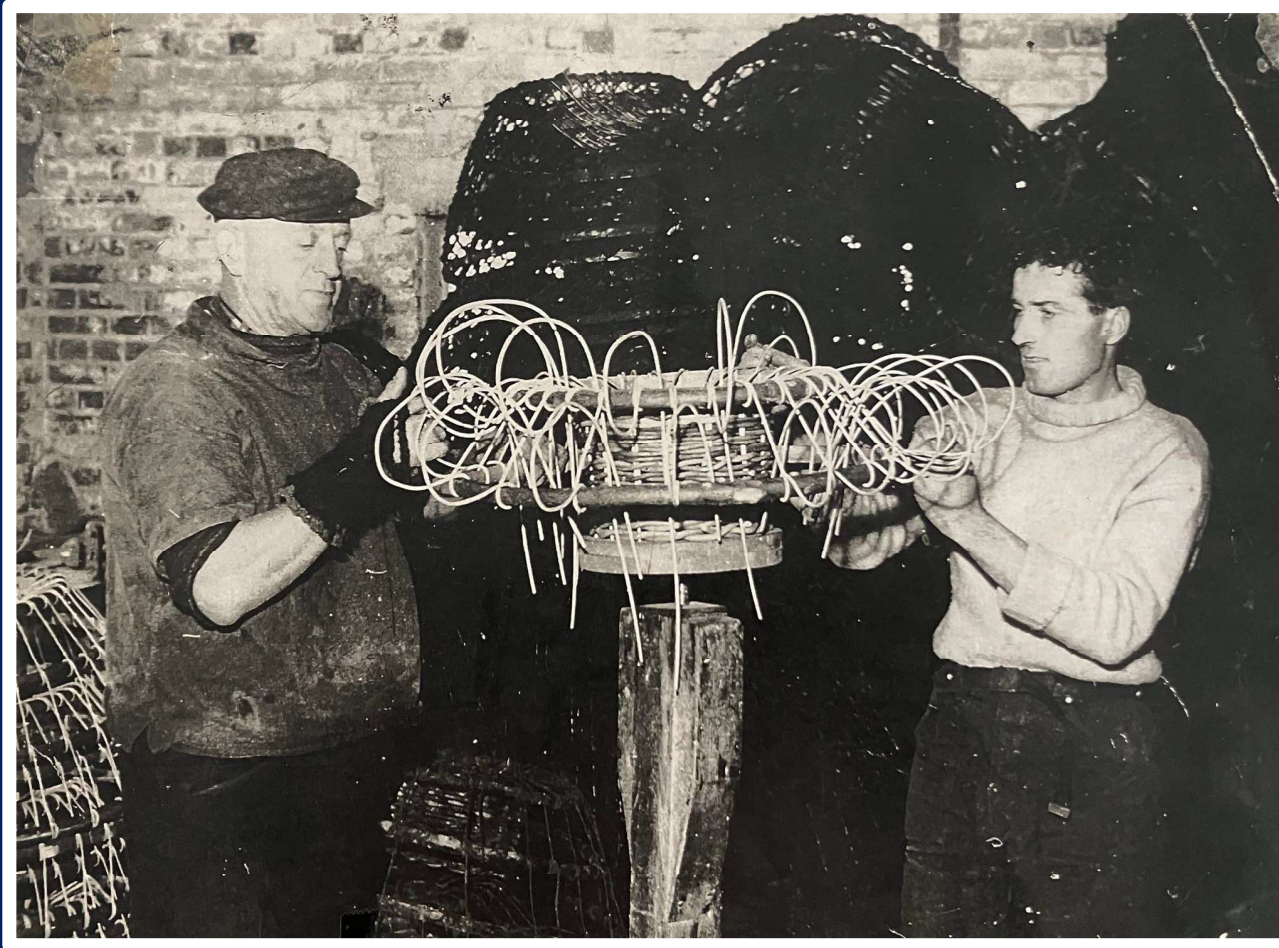

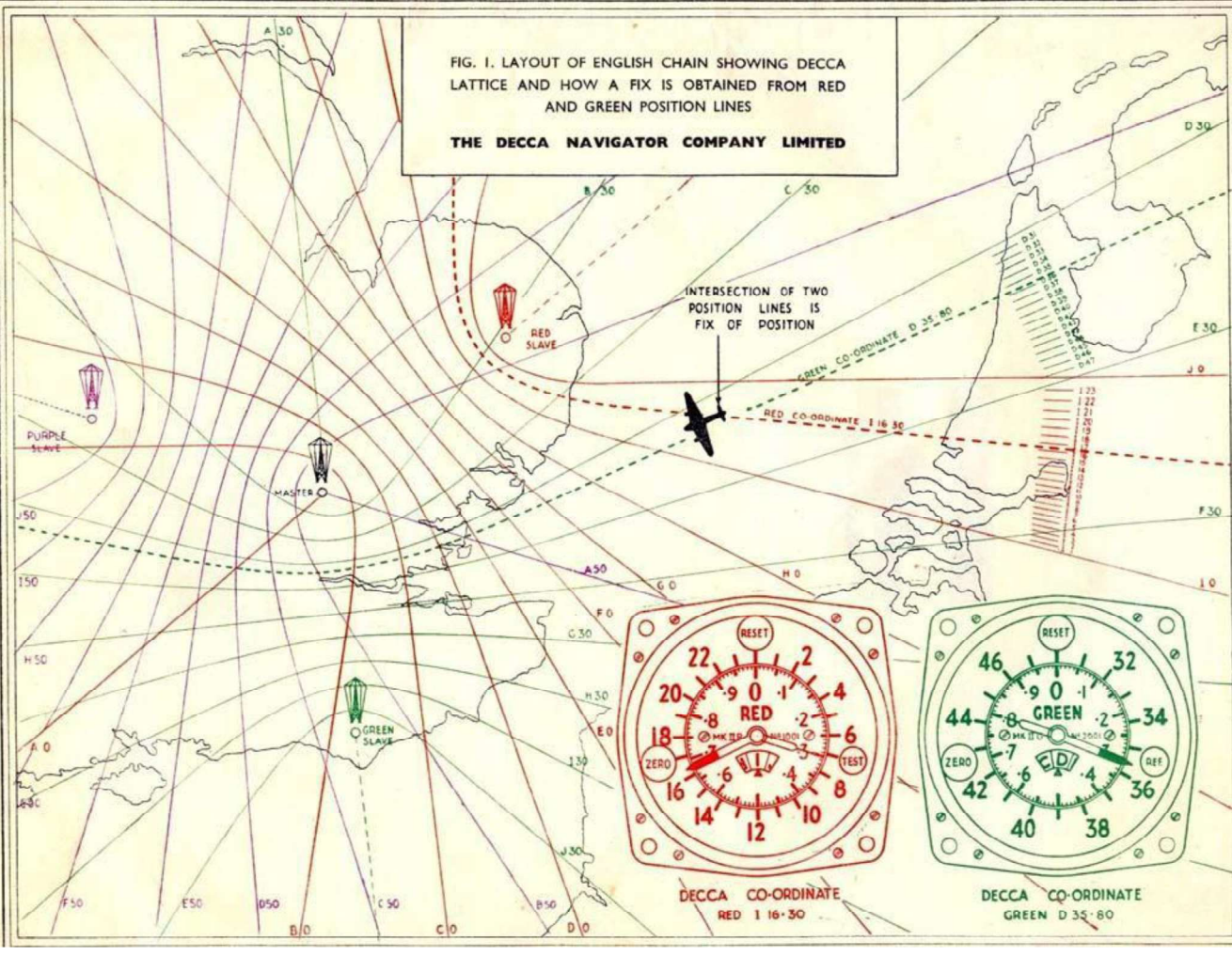

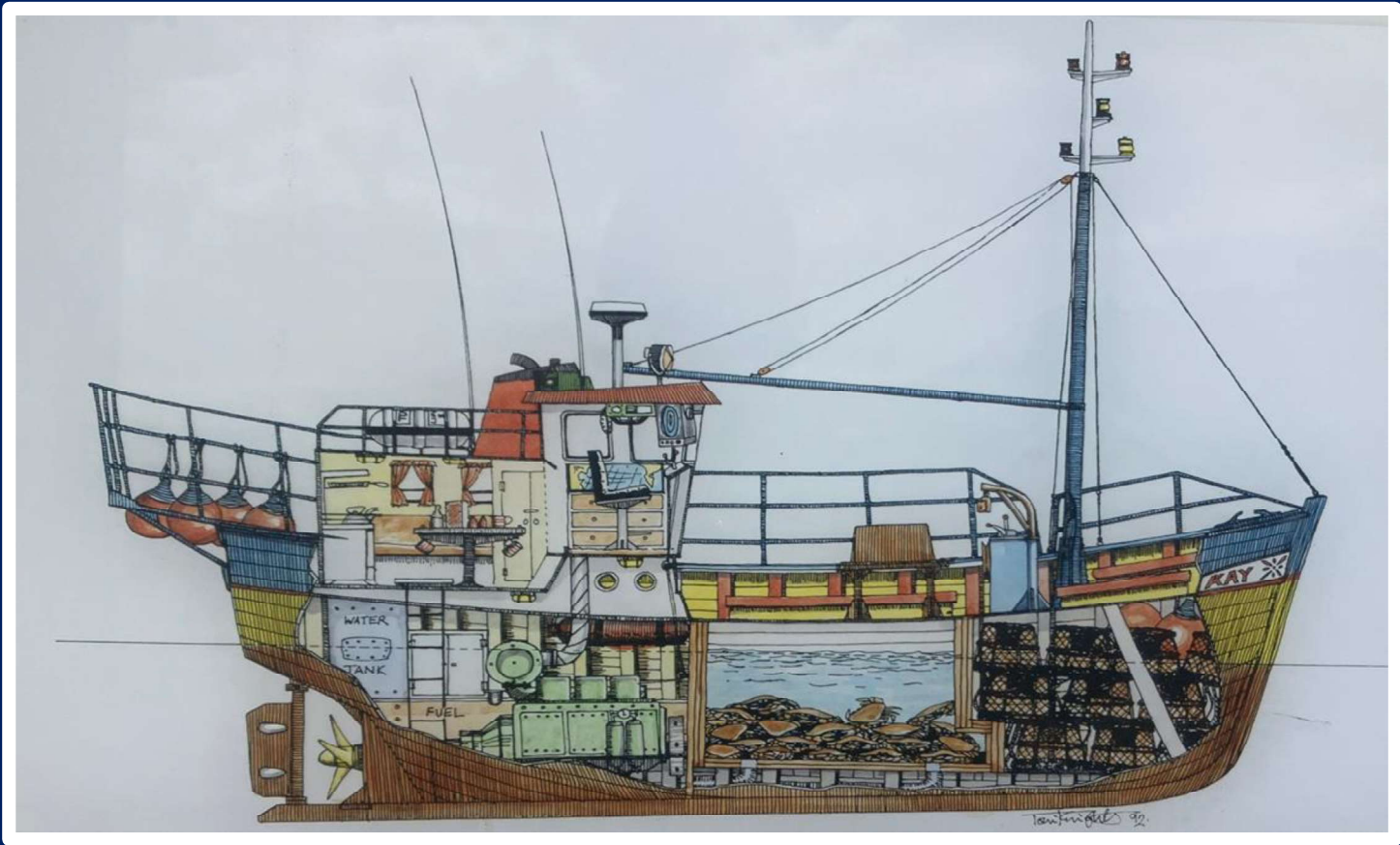


Communication area where potters will fish. Only can communicate by radio with digital potters in the vicinity of digital fishing activity within this area.

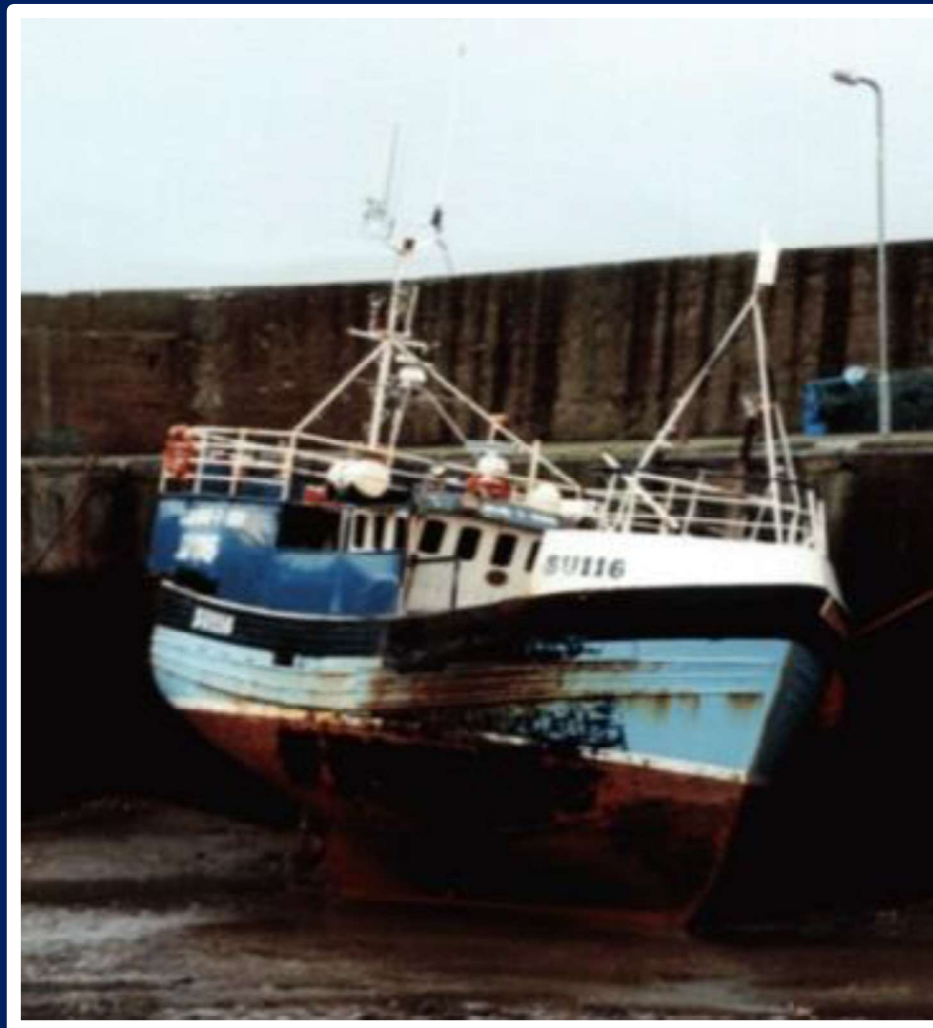

While they are in force, outlined and numbered areas (boxes) are to be used for potting gear. Three miles around each box is exclusive for trawling. During the changeover period (Chart A to Chart B) the following year, pots must, without fail, be removed from the boxes or areas to be suppressed, between the 15th and 17th of the month (3 days).
Les zones encadrées et numérotées (carrés) sont réservées aux casiers. Autour des carrés, une bande de trois miles est réservée exclusivement au chalutage.
